






The journey began with visits to Red Architecture Studio in Chennai interacting with the firm's architects and Mahabalipuram, where they explored Pallava-era marvels such as the Panch Rathas, Shore Temple, and Olakkaneswara Temple. At Crescent School Architecture and DakshinaChitra, students gained insights into South India's vernacular traditions.

In Thanjavur, they witnessed the grandeur of the Brihadeeswarar and Airavateswarar highlighting the Chola dynasty's craftsmanship. The trip concluded with a three-day settlement study in Udayalur, where students examined Agraharam houses and rural life, deepening their understanding of traditional Tamil settlements.
